

SHORT BIOGRAPHY

Gani Gërguri was born in Istog, Kosovo in 1960. A graduate with distinction of Faculty of Economics - University of Prishtina, he received his Postgraduate diploma on Management from Faculty of Economics – University of Zagreb in Croatia, and then he completed MBA in Finance with distinction from the University of Sheffield.

He started his career with National Bank of Kosovo in 1983 in statistics and analysis. He was employed at the CBK as Head of Research and Statistics Department in 2000, whereas in 2004 he was promoted in the position of Chief Operations Officer of the CBK. In January 2006, Mr. Gërguri was appointed as a Deputy Managing Director of the CBK, whereas in September 2008 the Governing Board of the CBK has appointed him as a Deputy Governor. Since 26th of July 2010, Mr.Gërguri was appointed as Acting Governor.

He is chairing the Statistics and Economic Analysis Committee of the CBK and he is also the editor-in-chief of periodical and occasional publications of the CBK. Mr.Gërguri is co-chairing the National Payments Council and he is a member of the Board of the Financial Intelligence Unit of Kosovo.

Mr. Gërguri has participated and contributed in many international conferences on central banking and financial stability issues and he has also completed specialized three-months course organized at the IMF's headquarter on Financial Programming and Policies. In addition, he has completed a one year Professional Development Program as well as a Leadership Program organized by the USAID.

His fields of interest include: financial economics and stability, macroeconomics, payments systems, and corporate governance.

He is fluent in English and Serbian.

He is married to his wife Muzaferre, and has two sons Elion (18) and Arion (14).
